<u>Moreas Concession Project</u> includes Korinthos – Tripoli - Kalamata Motorway and Lefktro - Sparti branch that form the trunk Road network of Central Peloponnese in Greece. It involves the rehabilitation-upgrading of the existing motorway Korinthos – Tripoli and the new motorway Tripoli-Kalamata & Lefktro – Sparti.
